**Chinese symbols**

Strength

Peace

Happiness

**Hen hao**

Very good

**Híjole que curvas y yo sin frenos**

Literally, gosh what curves and me without brakes. In reference to a beautiful woman

**Huauzontle**

Mexican vegetable resembling broccoli

**Jefe de la cocina**

Chief cook

**Ji zhu ni zi ji shi**

Don't forget

**Kufi**

A brimless, short, rounded cap worn by men in Africa

**Kyrie eleison**

Literally, Lord have mercy upon us. Taken from the Roman Catholic mass. Greek.

**Molto bene cameriere**

Very good waiter. Italian

**Ni hao or ni hao ma**

How are you?

**Ni ming bai le ma?**
